corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Minnesota  
and authorized to transact surety business in the State of Washington, as Surety, by this bond bind ourselves  
and our heirs, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns, jointly and severally, to pay the State of  
Washington Six Thousand (\$6000.00) dollars lawful money of the United States of America.


the Principal has applied for a Plumbing Contractor Certificate, from the Plumber Certification section of the  
Washington State Department of Labor and Industries, to carry on the business of a plumbing contractor in the  
State of Washington. The Principal is require by chapter 18.106 of the Revised Code of Washington (RCW) to  
furnish a bond in the penal sum Six Thousand (\$6000.00) dollars with good and sufficient surety. The bond must  
conditioned as required by RCW 18.106.410

If the Principal, in compliance with the provisions of chapter 18.106 RCW, pays all (1) wages and benefits to  
persons furnishing labor to the Principal, (2) amounts that may be adjudged against the Principal by reason of  
breach of contract including negligent or improper work in the conduct of the contracting business, (3) persons  
who furnish labor and materials or rent or supply equipment to the Principal, and (4) taxes and contributions  
due to the State of Washington, the obligation of the Principal and the Surety shall be null and void. If the  
Principal does not pay the above claims, the bond shall remain in full force and effect. In no case shall the  
Surety be liable for any claim not included in the RCW 18.106.410.

Any person that has a claim against the Principal, arising from the failure of the Principal to pay and of the four  
items referred to in paragraph 3, may bring suit upon the bond in the superior court of the county in which the  
work was done, or of any county in which the court has jurisdiction over the Principal. The suit must be brought  
within the time and the manner required by RCW 18.106.410

The aggregate liability of the Surety under this bond for claims against this bond shall not exceed the penal  
sum of this bond. No extension by continuation certificate, reinstatement, reissue, or renewal of this bond shall  
increase the liability of the Surety. If the claims against the bond that are pending at any one time exceed the  
remainder of the aggregate liability minus the amounts previously paid by the Surety because of other claims  
against this bond, the claims shall be satisfied in accordance with the provisions of RCW 18.106.410.

This bond shall become effective on 12/01/2022 and shall be void if not filed with the Plumber's  
Certification section by 1/1/2023 and shall remain in force continuously unless the Surety gives  
written notice to the Director of Labor and Industries of its intent to cancel the bond. A cancellation or  
of the bond or withdrawal of the Surety from the bond suspends the plumbing contractor license issued to the  
registrant until a new bond or reinstatement notice has been filed and approved as provided in the statute.

**POWER OF ATTORNEY**

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That Western National Mutual Insurance Company, a Minnesota mutual insurance company, does make, constitute, and appoint: Mark S. Hewitt of Western National Mutual Insurance Company

Its true and lawful Attorney(s)-in-Fact, with full power and authority for and on behalf of the Company as surety, to execute and deliver and affix the seal of the Company thereto (if a seal is required) bond, undertakings recognizances or other written obligations in the nature thereof, **(other than bail bonds, bank depository bonds, mortgage deficiency bonds, mortgage guaranty bonds, guarantees of installment paper and note guaranty bonds, self-insurance workers compensation bonds guaranteeing payment of benefits, hazardous waste remediation bonds or black lung bonds)**, as follows:

RESOLVED that the president, any vice president, or assistant vice president in conjunction with the secretary or any assistant secretary, may appoint attorneys-in-fact or agents with authority as defined or limited in the instrument evidencing the appointment in each case, for and on behalf of the company to execute and deliver and affix the seal of the Company to bonds, undertakings, recognizances, and suretyship obligations of all kinds, and said officers may remove any such attorney-in-fact or agent and revoke any Power of Attorney previously granted to such person.

  - (iii) when duly executed and sealed (if a seal be required) by one or more attorneys-in-fact or agents pursuant to and within the limits of the authority evidenced by the Power of Attorney issued by the Company to such person or persons.

RESOLVED FURTHER that the signature of any authorized officer and the seal of the company may be affixed by facsimile to any Power of Attorney or certification thereof authorizing the execution and delivery of any bond, undertaking, recognizance, or other suretyship obligations of the Company; and such signature and seal when so used shall have the same force and effect as though manually affixed. 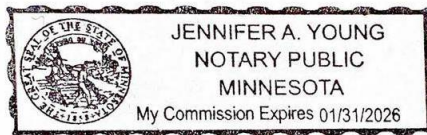
